We would like to offer the “NUFS Cross Cultural Exchange by Online” to NUFS students and international students from partner institutions. This program is aimed at student-to-student interaction and language learning. We look forward to having you join us!

### Period [8 weeks in total]

Session 1: From Monday, October 18<sup>th</sup> to Sunday, November 14<sup>th</sup> [4 weeks]

Session 2: From Monday, November 22<sup>nd</sup> to Sunday, December 19<sup>th</sup> [4 weeks]

\*The group members will be changed in the first and the second sessions.

**Partner Universities:** Students who would like to exchange language and culture with Japanese students

**NUFS:** Students who would like to exchange language and culture with international students

### Program

#### I. Orientation **\*Please be sure to participate or watch the archived video.**

- Date: 5 p.m. October 11<sup>th</sup> Monday (JAPAN TIME)
- Using device: ZOOM
- Way to participate: We will inform you of the participation URL beforehand.
- Details: Explanation of implementation method

#### II. Weekly online exchange

- Date and time: Once a week, 1 hour \* Please discuss with your group members and decide the date and time.
- Using device: Discord (<https://discord.com/>) \* We will inform you how to use Discord.
- Languages: ① Japanese and English ② English only ③ Japanese and French ④ Japanese and Chinese  
\*If you choose ①, ③ or ④, please do language exchange using Japanese plus English, French or Chinese, (For example, if you choose ①, your group members speak Japanese for 30 minutes + English for 30 minutes.)
- For non-native English speakers: English level B2 (CEFR) is desirable if you choose ① Japanese and English or ② English only”.

\* This is not the case for NUFS students as they are learning English. Please help NUFS students practice English conversation. NUFS students will help you with your Japanese conversation as well.
