## 2020 Fall Orientation at UT

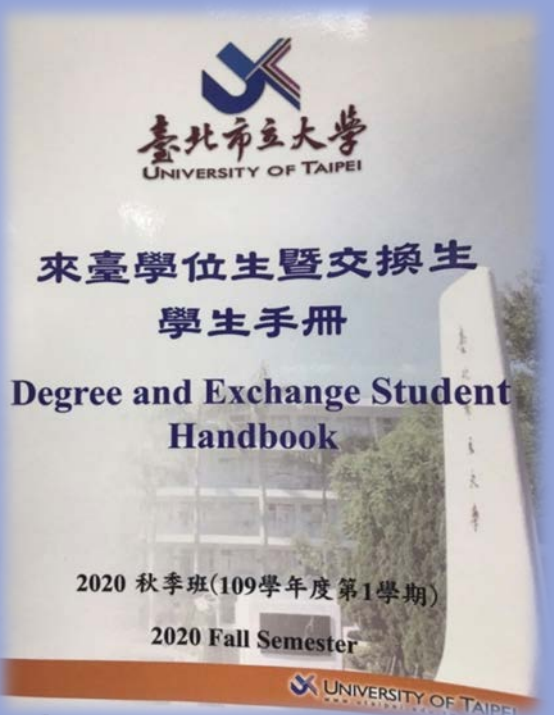
