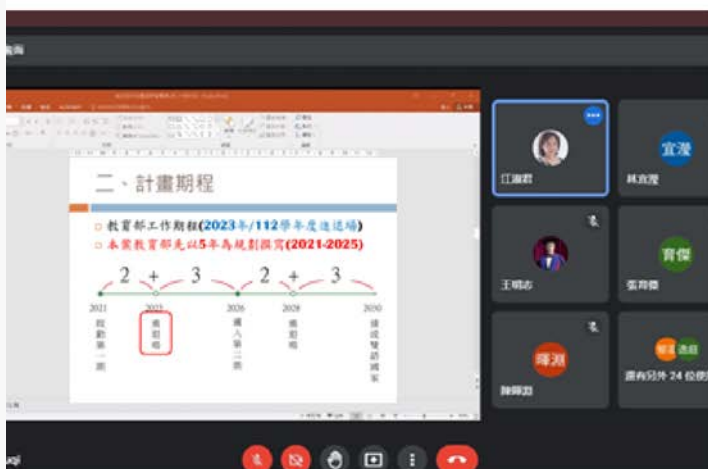
In response to the trend of globalization, the Ministry of Education (MOE) will launch the "The Program on Bilingual Education for Students in College" in September 2021, hoping to enhance college students' English proficiency and increase their global and cultural competencies. This new program will promote English-taught courses or English as a Medium of Instruction Courses (EMI) and improve the overall international competitiveness of higher education.

In accordance with the MOE's bilingual nation policy, the University of Taipei (UT) held a workshop with the topic of EMI teaching strategies on June 29, 2021. It was our honor to invite Dr. Keith M. Graham to share his research and teaching experience about "Supporting Student Learning in the EMI Classroom." The main goals of this workshop are to define EMI courses and clarify the pedagogical strategies for supporting students in EMI courses.
