

### 2021 UT SDGs 14 International Exchange Workshop I SDGs 14 Life below Water



The Office of International Affairs hosted a workshop in the form of an international exchange workshop in September and invited international experts and scholars in marine science to conduct joint courses online. The workshop centers around Goal 14 of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Goal 14 is all about the sustainable use of water resources in the environment. The purpose of the goal is to conserve marine resources, sustainably use water resources, safeguard biodiversity, and prevent environmental degradation.

During the four-day workshop from September 13 to 16, Prof. Ik Joon Kang from the School of Interdisciplinary Science and Innovation, Kyushu University, and Prof. Yun-Chih Liao from the Department of Earth and Life Science, University of Taipei, were invited to give lectures on Japanese environmental issues on coastal areas, as well as marine biodiversity and environmental issues, respectively. Students accepted by the workshop were from Italy, Taiwan, Japan, Thailand, and India.
