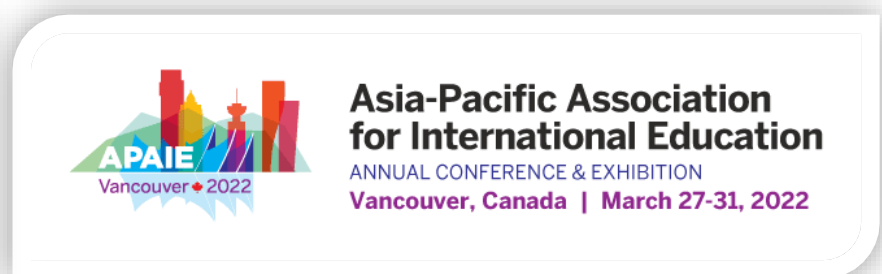
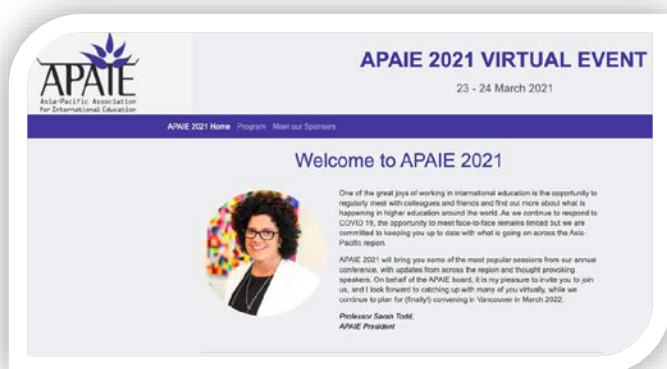


Under the influence of COVID-19 pandemic, many international projects between the University of Taipei and other higher education institutions are conducted online.
