Inaugural Ceremony of University of Taipei's 3rd President

The election committee of the University of Taipei announced on July 22 that Yin-Hao Chiu, professor of the Department of Urban Development, was elected as the university's President and took office on August 1.

Yin-Hao Chiu is a professor in the Department of Urban Development of the University of Taipei, where he served as the department chair. He held the positions of the dean of the College of City Management and the acting President of the University of Taipei from August 2021 to June 2022.

President Yin-Hao Chiu graduated with a Ph.D. from the School of Architecture and Built Environment at the University of Nottingham, UK, and an MSc degree from the Welsh School of Architecture at Cardiff University, UK.

He has also held several important positions in government departments and non-governmental organizations.

President Chiu has positioned the University of Taipei as a comprehensive university concerned with urban development, with the following three goals as its vision:

- A model university for teacher education
- A nurturing ground for gold medalists
- A think tank for urban research

The faculties of the University of Taipei cover social sciences, natural sciences, engineering, humanities and arts, and life sciences. In the future, UT will continue its tradition and pursuit of innovation, enhance its academic expertise, and keep a close connection with society and the international community. UT will become a unique university based in Taipei City that participates in and promotes urban development in line with international and global trends.
