The other course was Sports and Culture, which mainly allowed us to understand the development history of sports in European countries, and also allowed us to learn about the development and connection of sports at different political, economic, cultural and social levels and in different periods.

The location of the house and the surrounding living functions are also things to consider. These are things I have not learned before. In addition, I traveled to many places during these six months. In addition to learning a lot of travel skills and becoming more independent, I also saw many different sceneries in each country and learned about the development history and characteristics of many countries. For example, the Colosseum in Rome can witness the glory and history of the ancient Roman Empire, and the aurora seen in Norway allowed me to witness the power of nature. These are things I cannot learn from textbooks, and they are also very valuable experiences for me in the past six months.
